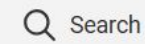
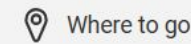



# Things to Consider Before Making the Choice

- Check that IFG grades are up-to-date.
- Consult your teachers about the predicted grades for the course (January intake).
- Consult your Academic Director about the overall predicted grade.
- Check your IELTS score and your IFG Academic English Test (AET) score OR consult your Academic English teacher about your predicted score. (IFG AET is accepted at the University of East London, the University of Gloucestershire, Anglia Ruskin University, the University of Central Lancashire and the University of Chester).
- Schedule your IELTS exam.
- Consider living costs in the city where your choices are located (a [Guide to UK Study & Living Costs](#) will be shared with you).
- Consider the tuition fees; consult your parents.

Note: Your insurance choice is a second choice and it should be used as a backup. You will ONLY get the opportunity to attend if you are not accepted on your firm choice AND you meet the conditions of your insurance choice.

You don't have to have an insurance choice. Please only choose one if you want to make this commitment.

The conditions for your insurance choice should be less than those required by your firm choice, as this will increase your chances of being accepted on a course should you not meet the conditions set by your firm choice.


