Enrolment and General Introduction to IFG - this session covers a wide range of topics, most of which will be covered in greater detail in other sessions.

Pharos, Perlego - learning resources which support your lessons. Pharos is our Virtual Learning Environment ((VLE), and Perlego is the name of our online library of textbooks. This session will show you how to use these resources effectively.

Grammarly - all students have access to Grammarly which is an online tool to help students with spelling and grammar, phrasing, and avoiding plagiarism. This session will also help to guide you on the use and misuse of AI during your studies.

Welfare & Student Support - living in another country and away from home should be an exciting experience, but it can also be stressful at times. This session will give you guidance on some of these challenges, and show you the support which is available.

Applying to Universities - it seems quite early to be talking about applying to universities, but the sooner we start this process, the better. This session will give you some initial guidance.

Buffet lunch and Selection of Student Representatives - this session is a little later than the other to allow late arrivals to participate. It will give you the chance to get to know other students taking different courses from you, and also your teachers. At this lunch, students will choose who they want to select as their representatives.
